The first season of the Nickelodeon television show Avatar: The Last Airbender was released on DVD on March 28, 2007. This first-season DVD includes commentary by the show's creators, with portions of the interviews spliced together to complete the commentary. The present invention is directed to a process for effecting conversion of natural gas, primarily composed of methane, into a product rich in hydrogen. More particularly, this invention is directed to a two-step process involving the conversion of natural gas to produce a crude mixed gas (methane and hydrogen) which is then subjected to a methanation step to produce a crude hydrogen rich gas (methane and hydrogen). In the past, processes for the partial combustion of natural gas have been available for the conversion of natural gas to carbon dioxide and residual natural gas. However, such prior art processes generally fail to eliminate all of the natural gas. In addition, such prior art processes generally require an inventory of natural gas to be stored at the site of the process. Thus, there is a need for an improved process for converting natural gas into a hydrogen rich gas wherein all of the natural gas is consumed.
